## Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 (NIV)

# The Bible Speaks of Silence in Several Ways:

#### Reverence to God

Habakkuk 2:20 (GW)

20 The LORD is in his holy temple. All the earth should be silent in his presence.

## **Expression of Despair**

Lamentations 2:10 (CEV)

10 Zion's leaders are silent. They just sit on the ground, tossing dirt on their heads and wearing sackcloth. Her young women can do nothing but stare at the ground.

# Silence as Opposition

Matthew 22:34 (NKJV)

34 But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together.

#### Silence as a Dramatic Pause

Revelation 8:1 (NKJV)

1 When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour.

20 We cannot stop talking about what we've seen and heard."

#### There are other times when...

Luke 23:9 (CEV)

9 Herod asked him a lot of questions, but Jesus did not answer.

Isaiah 62:6-7 (CEV)

6 Jerusalem, on your walls I have stationed guards, whose duty it is to speak out day and night, without resting. They must remind the LORD 7 and not let him rest till he makes Jerusalem strong and famous everywhere.

Luke 23:9 (CEV)

9 Herod asked him a lot of questions, but Jesus did not answer.

## **Jesus Silent Before the High Priest**

Matthew 26:62 (NKJV)

62 And the high priest arose and said to Him, "Do You answer nothing? What is it these men testify against You?"

#### **Jesus Silent Before Pilate**

John 19:10 (NKJV)

10 Then Pilate said to Him, "Are You not speaking to me? Do You not know that I have power to crucify You, and power to release You?"

Matthew 7:6 (NRSV) cautions:

"Do not give what is holy to dogs; and do not throw your pearls before swine, or they will trample them under foot and turn and maul you."

## 1) Speak your conviction, but be prudent.

# 2) When God answers by saying nothing, it is still an answer.

Matthew 7:6 (NRSV) cautions:

# 3) Not saying anything isn't a cop-out; it can be wise.
