2 Kings 2:8-10 (NLT)

8 Then Elijah folded his cloak together and struck the water with it. The river divided, and the two of them went across on dry ground! 9 When they came to the other side, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me what I can do for you before I am taken away." And Elisha replied, "Please let me inherit a double share of your spirit and become your successor." 10 "You have asked a difficult thing," Elijah replied. "If you see me when I am taken from you, then you will get your request. But if not, then you won't."

Big Idea of the Message: Change and transition are a fact of life. Some changes are for the better, others for the worst.

Application Point: Some things never change. "I the Lord change not." (Malachi 3:6a NIV) How can we remain faithful to God through changing times? By understanding that change happens and how to navigate it.

Is your life —

a question mark because you're searching for answers? a comma because you're in transition? a period because everything seems to be at a standstill? or a dash because you're in a constant hurry?

Big Difference Between Change and Transition

Change is External: It is something that happens to people, even if they don't welcome it. WITH CHANGE, YOU'RE NOT ALWAYS IN CONTROL.

Transition is Internal: It's what happens in you (internal processes) as you go through change. WITH TRANSITION, YOU'RE IN CONTROL.

The Transition Model

THREE STAGES OF CHANGE

1. IME	STAGE
2 Kings 2:9-10 (JKJV)
9 And so it was, when they had crossed over, that Elijah said to Elisha, "Ask! What may I do for yo before I am taken away from you?" Elisha said, "Please let a double portion of your spirit be upon me." 10 So he said, You have asked a hard thing. Nevertheless, if you see me when I am taken fro you, it shall be so for you; but if not, it shall not be so."

2 Kings 2:11-12	(NLT)

2 Kings 2:13-14	(NLT)

14 He struck the water with Elijah's cloak and cried out, "Where is the LORD, the God of Elijah?"
