3. VISION _____ (a dream drought)

Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)

18 Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.

A VISION DOES THREE THINGS:

- (1) A vision will free you from your past.
- (2) A vision will set you on a collision course with your destiny.
- (3) A vision will cause your strengths to increase and your weaknesses to decrease.

A VISION WILL ALWAYS CONSIST OF THREE THINGS:

- (1) Aspiration: a strong desire for high achievement.
- (2) Inspiration: a vision must be God-breathed or divinely influenced.
- (3) Perspiration: A vision will always necessitate vigorous effort to accomplish.

Tunnel vision: tunnel vision is the loss of peripheral vision with retention of central vision.
