# **Straightaway**

## Mark 1:1-8 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. <sup>2</sup> As it is written in the Prophets: "Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, Who will prepare Your way before You." <sup>3</sup> "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the LORD; Make His paths straight." <sup>4</sup> John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. <sup>5</sup> Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins. <sup>6</sup> Now John was clothed with camel's hair and with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. <sup>7</sup> And he preached, saying, "There comes One after me who is mightier than I, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to stoop down and loose. <sup>8</sup> I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

### **Deuteronomy 2:1-3 (NASB)**

<sup>1</sup> "Then we turned and set out for the wilderness by the way to the Red Sea, as the LORD spoke to me, and circled Mount Seir for many days. <sup>2</sup> "And the LORD spoke to me, saying, <sup>3</sup> 'You have circled this mountain long enough. Now turn north,

#### Luke 3:4-6 (CEV)

<sup>4</sup> Isaiah the prophet wrote about John when he said, "In the desert someone is shouting, 'Get the road ready for the Lord! Make a straight path for him. <sup>5</sup> Fill up every valley and level every mountain and hill. Straighten the crooked paths and smooth out the rough roads. <sup>6</sup> Then everyone will see the saving power of God."

## **How Do We Change Course?**

#### 1. MAKE A U-TURN

"proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins" (v. 4).

True repentance isn't merely feeling sorry but changing course.

John's baptism of repentance is better translated as:

- A baptism "to show that they had turned from their sins and turned to God" (New Living Translation).
- · A baptism "to show that they were changing their hearts and lives" (Common English Bible).
- "A baptism of life-change" (The Message).
- "people from the whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins" (v. 5).

#### 2. WE NEED A NEW POWER SOURCE

"is more powerful than I," the one who "will baptize you with the Holy Spirit" (vv. 7-8).
