THREE ELEMENTS TO EFFECTIVE PRAYING

1. Pray in faith.

Matthew 21:21-22 (NJB)

²¹ Jesus answered, 'In truth I tell you, if you have faith and do not doubt at all, not only will you do what I have done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, "Be pulled up and thrown into the sea," it will be done.
²² And if you have faith, everything you ask for in prayer, you will receive.'

2. Pray with the right motive.

James 4:3 (CEV)

³ Yet even when you do pray, your prayers are not answered, because you pray just for selfish reasons.

3. Pray and don't give up.

Luke 18:1 (NLT)

¹ One day Jesus told his disciples a story to show that they should always pray and never give up.

GIVE

in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NKJV)

1 Thessalonians 5:16-24 (NKJV)

THREE ELEMENTS TO GIVING

1. Give cheerfully.

2 Corinthians 9:7 (GW)

⁷ Each of you should give whatever you have decided. You shouldn't be sorry that you gave or feel forced to give, since God loves a cheerful giver.

2. Give generously.

1 Chronicles 29:14 (GW)

¹⁴ But who am I and who are my people that you enable us to give so generously? Everything comes from you. We give you only what has come from your hands.

3. Give expectantly.

Luke 6:38 (TLB)

³⁸ For if you give, you will get! Your gift will return to you in full and overflowing measure, pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, and running over. Whatever measure you use to give—large or small—will be used to measure what is given back to you."
