Psalm 81:10,16 (NLT)

¹⁰ For it was I, the LORD your God, who rescued you from the land of Egypt. Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it with good things. ¹⁶ But I would feed you with the finest wheat. I would satisfy you with wild honey from the rock.
