PARENTING TIPS

(Help Our Kids Learn Patience)

- You can model patience before your kids.
- Stir up a conversation about patience (or impatience).
- Some parents use timers when appropriate.
- Assign your kids responsibilities that will require more time and thus more patience.
- You don't always have to give your kids what they want immediately.

Three Reasons God Makes Us Wait
1.Waiting Informs
1 Corinthians 4:5 (HCSB) 5 Therefore don't judge anything prematurely, before the Lord comes, who will both bring to light what is hidden in darkness and reveal the intentions of the hearts. And then praise will come to each one from God.

3.Waiting Teaches

Jeremiah 5:4 (TLB)
